<p>Day 1</p>	<p>Leave Arusha at 10:00 am passing through the hustle and bustle of Arusha town continuing out to Tarangire National Park. Enter the park for game drives of the Elephant playground. Game drives en route to Tarangire Safari Lodge for hot lunch and relaxation followed by afternoon game drives.</p> <div data-bbox="560 1317 1326 1742" style="text-align: center;"> </div> <p>Mid afternoon slowly leave the park and depart towards Tarangire Tamarind Camp located just outside Tarangire National Park.</p> <p>O/N Tarangire Tamarind Camp - F/B</p>	
<p>Day 2</p>	<p>After Breakfast drive the short distance to Tarangire National Park for full day game drives to your own design. Picnic lunch at the view point looking over a section of the Tarangire river. Mid afternoon leave the park and return to Tamarind Camp.</p> <p>O/N Tarangire Tamarind Camp - F/B</p>	

Day 3

After breakfast head towards Lake Manyara National Park for game drives of the garden of Eden. There is a wide variety of resident wildlife in the park, if you are lucky you may see the tree climbing lions, along with resident elephant population and an abundance of aquatic birdlife. Manyara also boast a very active and large population of primates.
Leave the park around noon and head towards Esilalei Maasai community. Meet with your local Maasai guide for an introduction into the Maasai way of life, beliefs and rituals.



Get a better understanding of the natural medicines still used on a daily basis during the Maasai medicine walk of the surrounding area. Visit a Boma (Mud dwelling) for a look behind the scenes as to the living arrangements to one of these mud huts. Leave the community and drive the short distance back to Manyara Ranch in time for sundowner drinks.

After diner join the night game drive vehicle for a game drive under the stars - return to the camp for relaxation and overnight

Day 4

Dawn walking safari of the ranch - view wildlife from a ground level and return to the camp for full breakfast.

Plan the rest of your day with your driver guide - head out for game drives in the ranch or relax at the natural setting of Manyara Conservancy camp.

Dawn game drive or walking safari before leaving the ranch and heading back to Arusha. You'll be dropped off at Arusha Airport where you connect with your domestic flight to Zanzibar.
